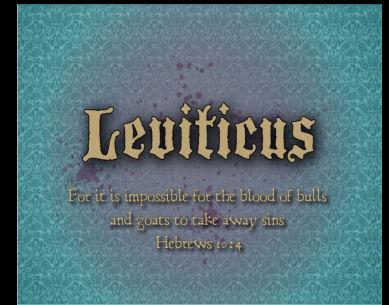
Worship Choir Practice

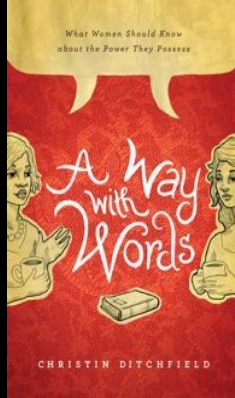


Ladies' Transformation

Bible Study

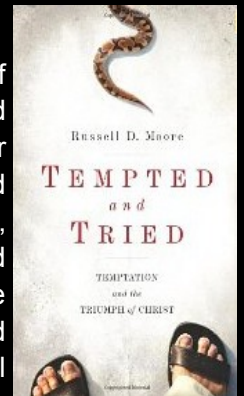
